

This competition allows for the transition from Milo cricket to a formal cricket competition with hard cricket balls and protective equipment.

As can be seen from the following rules it is a more inclusive competition with the emphasis on development and participation more so than winning prior to entering a higher and more competitive level.

6.3.7 Modified rules for Under-12E grade competition

6.3.7.1 Final year under-12 players will not be permitted to play in this competition.

6.3.7.2 Two-day games will be played as usual except that each team will bat 20 overs on the first day, and again on the second day.

6.3.7.3 Bowlers will bowl two overs only on each day, whilst batsmen will retire after facing 30 balls.

6.3.7.4 An over will consist of six balls only, including wides and no-balls.

6.3.7.5 All bowling to be from one end only. Ends to be selected by mutual agreement of the team managers.

6.3.7.6 No finals games will be played in this competition, however an extra game will be played at the end of the season by all teams.
