Bentleigh Cricket Club - Our Profile

Bentleigh Cricket Club was established in August 1909 and in season 2016/2017, we celebrated our 107th season.

Our aim is to foster an active participation in sport (cricket) for junior and senior players of all ages and gender, while providing a responsible and enjoyable social environment for members, families, and supporters.

We currently have five senior teams, six junior teams and run the successful Milo In2 Cricket program and T20 Blast program (one of the largest in the region).

Our seniors are affiliated with the Cricket Southern Bayside (CSB) and the Mercantile Cricket associations (MCA) with our top three Senior teams playing in a two-day competition on Saturdays and our Masters and lower grades playing in one-day competitions on Sundays. All senior teams play on turf.

Our juniors are affiliated with SECA and are comprised of U16's, U14's, U12's and Rookies.

Our main ground is Bentleigh Recreation Reserve located at Arthur St Bentleigh (behind the Bentleigh RSL), with our second ground at Centenary Park Oval 2, located at Bignell Rd, East Bentleigh. Our juniors play at Duncan Mackinnon Reserve and Victory Park, while our Milo In2 Cricket and T20 Blast Programs run on a Friday night at our main ground in Bentleigh.

We welcome players of all ages, gender and skill, and encourage anyone to come down and be a part of what has been an amazing Club for more than 100 years.

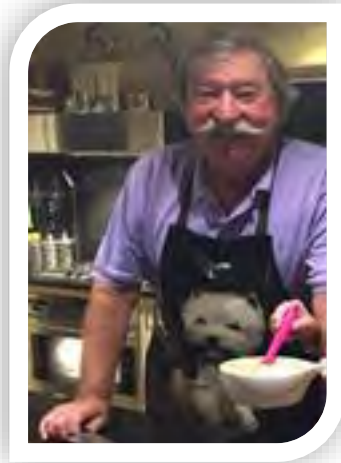

On Wednesday the 4th of January 2017, Bentleigh Cricket Club said goodbye to its greatest, player and clubman, Ronald "RGL" Laird.

Ron passed away in hospital after battling an illness for which he was diagnosed in mid-2016.

In my time at the Bentleigh cricket club, I have made many lifelong friends. However, with great respect to others, Ron Laird was a standout. He was the man that signed me up to play cricket at Bentleigh in 1980. I enjoyed countless days of fun and pleasure on the cricket field, clubrooms, pubs, restaurants, homes, and had many adventures on holidays. He was a best friend, mentor, guiding light, and an iconic figure to myself, my kids, and many, many more around the club and in the community at large.



I spent a lot of time with Ron over the last 6 months of his life on earth, and it was the most pleasurable time spent with any human being. We talked and reminisced about the events over the past 40-odd years, some with new twists and further embellishment. As a man, father, husband, mate, sportsman, administrator – there will be no-one that will come close to this unique character we called "Lairdy". A person we all truly loved.



Ron was known in cricket circles state wide and his contribution to the sport saw him awarded an OAM in 2008 for both service to cricket through the Bentleigh and St Kilda Cricket Clubs, and through roles with regional and state cricket associations.

He won six 1st XI bowling awards, four 1st XI batting awards, four senior club champion trophies and was a six time 1st XI premierships player, including being Captain of the 1968-69 premierships team. These are just a few of his achievements. Season 1984-85 saw the introduction of the R.G Laird Award, an award given to the best 1st XI player, voted by the players themselves. It was a fitting acknowledgement of a champion player. Appropriately, Ron won this award in 1987-88, the same season he won his sixth 1st XI bowling award.

In 2008 at the Club's Centenary celebrations, Ron was named Captain of the Team of the Century.

Ron's contribution to the Bentleigh Cricket Club was not only on-field but also off-field where he played a pivotal role in the shaping of the Club, and is a huge reason why the club enjoys its on and off-field success today.

Having left Bentleigh to take on the role as President of St Kilda CC where he enjoyed huge success, Ron returned to Bentleigh in 2013 where he again took up the role of President, before stepping down in season 2016-17 due to illness.

The Bentleigh Cricket Club stands today a proud and successful Club because of RGL's contribution. A 14-time President of the Club and a Life Member, Ron embodied the spirit that is Bentleigh Cricket Club.

However, the real success is due to the Club members, some of whom are mentioned above, who had the foresight to recognise that the future of the Club was tied in with the re-establishment of a vibrant junior section. A lot of the hard work has now been done but we all know how quickly it can become undone if we take our collective foot off the pedal

The feeding ground for our juniors is the Milo program with many helpers. Friday nights at Arthur Street have become very much a social event, with parents of the Milo kids enjoying an end of week wine or two, watching the kids learn our great game. The sausage sizzle by Scott Russell and Roger Kellar, supported by Daniel Clarke behind the bar, combined with the RSL provided vouchers for free under 12's meals has proved a great success.

It will be even bigger with the continued success of the 20/20 Milo Big Blast also happening on Friday nights at Arthur Street. It is a fabulous way to foster junior cricket and Cricket Victoria is to be congratulated for developing and funding this initiative.

The committee, executive, coaches, managers and many other contributors are to be congratulated for their efforts.

A bright spot for us has been the development of the younger brigade. We have a group of ten or so mid to late teens who show tremendous promise with more in the pipeline from the junior section. Many of the youngsters played in the seconds and thirds whilst also being active in assisting with the Milo and juniors. Other than a couple of these players, the rest have been in a holding pattern for one reason or another. We trust they all get back and have full seasons of cricket, and progress and fulfil their potential.

This only emphasises the importance of producing our own home -grown cricketers – as we need to nurture, guide and develop these young men, a major emphasis of the Club now and will be in the future. The balancing act, between overseas and local talent, will be judged on how quickly they step up

The Senior teams had their moments of glory but narrowly missed the finals. The first and fourth eleven won through to the semi-finals but did not go all the way. The third eleven were there about, but fell short. The success story was the second eleven, who won the Premiership.

The 1st Eleven lead by Rob Ciccarella had some great moments during the season. This enhanced the bond between the group and lead to a more cohesive unit. An example of the tight unit was the night they celebrated hard with teammates, wives, girl-friends and mates, after the win against Beaumaris. I believe that was the welding of the group as a unit. Even with the change of personnel next season, it is crucial that we maintain the momentum and culture. There is a strong great core group that remain, which gives me great confidence for the next season.

Congratulations to Paul Ciccarella on a great year, with the second eleven winning the premiership.

One thing that has become obvious to me in the last couple of years is the need for the senior section to become closer to the junior section and the many mums and dads who support their children in their cricket development. There are always at least half a dozen kids watching the seniors at Arthur Street on Saturdays and Sundays. They have a sense of belonging to Bentleigh, feel at home there and no doubt aspire to be senior Bentleigh cricketers. In my contact with the mums and dads it is clear that they too have a sense of belonging. This needs to be cultivated. When you take the numbers into account we have many more junior members than senior members. The parents of the juniors are in my view an untapped resource. If we can find a way to involve the parents more in the broader club it can only be to our advantage. Their contacts could prove invaluable and their support for fundraising efforts could only be positive.

I fully understand the bond between team- mates and the need to be together but if an extra effort can be made to welcome the parents and involve them it can only make the Club stronger. I hope to recommend to the committee and the Social Secretary that they consider appropriate functions for parents to let them know how we operate and to reinforce their status as Bentleigh people.

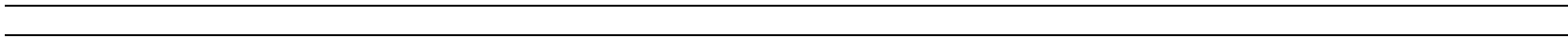



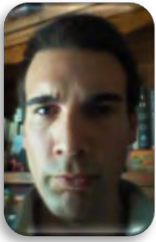
