Bentleigh Cricket Club was established in August 1909 and in season 2015/2016, we celebrated our 106th season.

Our aim is to foster an active participation in sport (cricket) for junior and senior players of all ages and gender, while providing a responsible and enjoyable social environment for members, families and supporters.

We field senior and junior teams, and run the successful Milo In2 Cricket program (formerly known as Milo Have-A-Go) and T20 Blast programs (one of the largest in the region).

Our seniors are affiliated with the Victorian Turf Cricket Association (from season 2016/17 Cricket Southern Bayside) and the Mercantile Cricket Association (MCA) with our top three Senior teams playing in a two-day competition on Saturdays and our lower grades playing in one day competitions on Sundays. All senior teams play on turf.

Our juniors are affiliated with SECA (formerly the CMCA) and are comprised of U16's, U14's, U12's and Rookies.

Our main ground is Bentleigh Recreation Reserve located at Arthur St Bentleigh (behind the Bentleigh RSL), with our second ground at Centenary Park Oval 2, located at Bignell Rd, East Bentleigh

Our juniors play at Duncan Mackinnon Reserve and Victory Park. Our Milo In2 Cricket and T20 Blast Programs run on a Friday night at our main ground in Bentleigh.

We welcome players of all ages, gender and skill, and encourage anyone to come down and be a part of what has been an amazing Club for more than 100 years.

## Presidents' Report

---



The season brought mixed results throughout the club.

The senior division was particularly disappointing with only a few glimmers in the lower elevens. Things were much brighter in the junior section which continues to develop with more and more parental involvement and enthusiastic youngsters making impressive progress.

Our first eleven was potentially a finals contender under new captain Rob Ciccarella with three overseas recruits to bolster our ranks. Unfortunately, a mixture of injury, form slumps and personal issues intruded and in the end it was a very disappointing season. As a consequence of this the entire senior section was affected with the cumulative pain filtering down through all teams. Despite this the seconds performed well particularly towards the end of the season when players became available and all teams were strengthened. The third eleven felt the non-availability more than most and were not finals contenders. The fourths and fifths both made the finals with the fourths led by club coach Dave McNamara ultimately winning the flag. The fifths narrowly lost out in the grand final but can be well pleased with their season under Dave Mullane and Chris Meister. The club is delighted with this, the first year for the fifths. This new eleven has given us the flexibility to play guys who do not want to be committed each week and to give juniors the opportunity to gain turf cricket experience. The number of dads being able to play with their sons has increased and is enhancing our reputation as a family club at which all are welcome.

The junior section continues to become stronger as the boys and girls mature into higher levels and our successful Milo program continues to bear fruit at the bottom end. The U12's managed to make the finals but lost in the semi-final in a very close game.

We did make significant progress in our administration during the season. It was necessary to cover the loss of Matt Thorp as Secretary and Steve McGinness as Junior Coordinator. Mick Foot and Steve Grogan slipped seamlessly into the respective roles and we congratulate them for their efforts. We still have Steve McGinness and Matt Thorp as significant contributors so our ranks of willing and capable administrators continues to expand.

Matt Thorp continued his great work in the Milo and T20 Big Blast on Friday nights at Arthur Street. The numbers continue to multiply as parents spread the word about how good our program is.

The offers of assistance from parents across all junior and Milo teams is gratifying and indicates that they share our vision of making Bentleigh a true family club where all can share our excellent facilities and at the same time enjoy a pathway for budding cricketers supported by excellent coaching and mentoring.



Our Secretary Mick Foot has performed admirably in all aspects of his role which is no mean feat for a first year appointment. In addition to his involvement across junior and senior elevens and his not inconsiderate administrative role, he has been active in establishing our winter team which may be a precursor for more winter teams in the future. How things have changed - in the past we could barely enjoy a game in summer which was not rain affected! All he needs now is the challenge of re-establishing our ladies' teams which were rampant in the VWCA in the 1980's and 1990's. We were ahead of the pack back then but the climate at present is quite different with women's cricket sharing equal billing at Cricket Victoria and gaining prominence at International level.

Our Junior Coordinator also made an auspicious debut. His enthusiasm, manner and organizational skills contributed to a successful year. If we could only clone him he would be an excellent replacement for Winnie Lim who is retiring after many years outstanding service as Social Secretary.

We honour Winnie as a great club person who did not ask for accolades – she just got the job done with excellent results and little fuss. I know I speak for all when I say that we hope to see her around for a long time to come.

Paul Ciccarella as Treasurer continues on in the role with outstanding outcomes and again with no fuss. Well done Paul.

I need not wax lyric on the work of Russell Keyt as we all know the efforts he puts in to further the interests of our club. He dreams about the club!

In closing I would like to thank all office bearers and committee for their contribution.

We are blessed with lots of people who do care about the Club and the image it portrays to the community. It is great to see that even after nearly 110 years and lots of other leisure activities which have developed, the Club is still well and truly relevant and an important part of our community.

## 1st XI Captains' Report

*A season of almost's...*

Firstly, it is an honour to join the captains club of the BCC. The responsibility of being captain of this great club has been my greatest challenge as a cricketer. To be mentioned in the same breath as previous club captains such as Laird, Roach, or McNamara is an achievement I'm extremely proud of. After a long winter of building a team with Dave and Russ, we put together a group of players that had the potential to play some great cricket. Unfortunately, it takes more than great players to make a great team. The season started strong with a close win over the old foe McKinnon. After good spread of performances with the bat and ball we ended up chasing down a large 1-day total of 175.

After Round 1 most of the season was very inconsistent.

When South Caulfield chased down our 279 it showed we had a lot of work to do on the training track to be up to scratch. We dropped a number of catches and our bowling was wayward. The trend continued against Yarraville and Strathmore - losing wickets in clumps and giving up chances with the ball happened too often. Obviously with these sorts of issues it was hard to win games of cricket.

On the other-hand, we had some incredible efforts. Larens' 5-for against Bonbeach to help bowl them out for 100. In the same game, we were 5/55 when Alex Caravalis and Rosh Livera put on a gutsy 60 to get us over the line without breaking their partnership, against probably the best bowler in the comp on a crumbling Bentleigh wicket.

Jordan Burns was another who demonstrated what he has to offer with a fabulous attitude and some success, claiming several wickets that had eluded his more experienced teammates and showing that he's no mug with the bat either. His late-season elevation to the 2nds was reward for his consistently hard work at training, and a chance for him to show just what he's capable of at higher levels, which he did.

Throw in cameos from Sam Mouzakis and Jackson Forster and the team had a good taste of Bentleigh's cricketing future, which is definitely bright.

We also had a fair slice of the past at times with the likes of Dave Mullane, John Forster, Mick Foot, Brad Coppens, Steve McGinness, Brett Arnfield and Steve Booth taking the field, and the captain also doing his bit to raise the average age.



Paul Evans was another senior player who returned to the club just in time to become a crucial member of the 3s' batting order, even though it took a while for his skipper to work out where he batted best. It wouldn't have been as prolific a season as Dodge wanted or expected, but nearly 300 runs - including 2 scores over 50 and a 49 – made him nearly our most successful batsman and a worthy winner of the John Rogers trophy.

The bowling was an area where we really struggled. Too often we bowled plenty of good balls but far too many bad ones, letting pressure off and making it easier for our opponents to score. Only 2 bowlers took more than 10 wickets for the season, which meant that the load was spread too far and too thinly.

Amid this, Damian Thomson was not only a reliable, dependable and consistent bowler, he was also vice-captain and way more often than anyone would like, himself included, a necessary contributor with the bat. Wherever and whenever he bowled he was more than a handful for the opposition.

Andrew Grove also had an inconsistent season both in terms of his role in the team and his returns with the ball, though his effort of 4/19 off 9 overs against Sacred Heart was a highlight, as was his greatly improved batting. But regardless of what he was asked to do for the team he unfailingly did so with enthusiasm, energy and positivity, making him an excellent teammate through tough times.

Adrian Razzi was another who brought an infectious enthusiasm to the side, plus some incredibly crisply smashed strokes and more than handy bowling. In fact, on our darkest day of the season, against Youlden Parkville away, Razz grabbed the first 2 wickets cheaply to put us on the front foot before the onslaught that followed. He's a fabulous bloke to have in any team and when he manages to stay in for longer than 10 overs at a time he will rip some bowling attacks apart.

Dylan Velleman had a season to forget in terms of personal achievements, but he learned plenty about his game and never let his own misfortunes pollute the team's morale. More patience with the bat and perseverance with the ball will see him put this season well behind him and improve in all facets of the game.

Dom Baldwin, our UK import, also played 5 games and finally produced some of his best cricket in the last, scoring 51 to make short work of our run-chase against ladder-leaders Parkville District and give us our first win since October. His bowling was also quick and lively on several occasions.

Adam Rodda surprised everyone with his emergence as a quality batsman, opening the innings on a few occasions and featuring in one of the few century partnerships of our season. His bowling was also useful, though not as productive as he would have liked in an interrupted season. Continued improvement in both areas will see him develop into a really useful player, as long as he can string some games together.



The captain came into this season with very little cricket in the previous 18 months and no certainty that his body would hold up, or that he would be able to compete at this level. Thankfully these worries were ill-founded and especially before Christmas, returns were good, if inconsistent.

The one piece of advice on offer after a season in which we scored too few runs to compete strongly most weeks is about how important it is to know your own game. Only time teaches these lessons, but the sooner any batsman or bowler realises where his strengths and weaknesses lie the better placed he is to capitalise on the good points and start working on the bad.

So that's where we leave a season that featured its fair share of highs and lows despite what the ladder might say.
